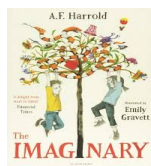
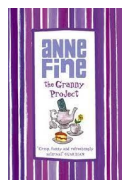
Light



Reading

We will be learning how to:

- Make inferences and justify them
- Explain and evidence our ideas about a text
- Engage with unfamiliar vocabulary
- Evaluate figurative language



Writing

We will be learning how to:

- Develop our stamina to allow us to write longer sustained pieces of work
- Explore narrative writing and poetry, taking inspiration from "Overheard in a Tower Block" and Clockwork by Philip Pullman.

Maths

- Recall factors, multiples and prime number at speed
- Find equivalent fractions

- Multiply, dividing, adding and subtracting fractions
- Solve problems involving fractions
- Approach problems in a variety of ways to solve and prove our reasoning
- Use Strategies to solve multi-step problems
