English

The children will spend the first few weeks exploring the techniques they need to be successful in their SATs reading tests.

Following this they will dive into the visually stunning **The Arrival** by Shaun Tan. The children will examine the themes of travel and isolation and draw comparisons to their own experiences.

Maths

The first part of the summer term will be focused on revising key learning from the past year to support children ahead of their SATs maths tests.

Following this we will then study topics that will help the children prepare for secondary school including ratio, proportion and algebra.

Science

We will continue with our topic of **Evolution and Inheritance** and will focus on:

- what fossils tell us about history
- how living things have adapted to suit their environment
- how adaptation may lead to evolution



Geography

Our new topic is 'Sharing the World' which will;

- deepen the children's understanding of how trade connects the world
- examine how different man made and natural resources are traded
- explore more sustainable ways to trade goods
