

## English

In English we will:

- read **After the Fall** and **Blown Away**
- write narrative stories where characters need to overcome problems
- write instructions for how to be resilient
- plan and draft our own poetry
- write a rhyming poem



## Maths

We will be learning to:

- measure capacity, volume and mass
- estimate and measure in millilitres and litres
- weigh and compare mass in grams and kilograms
- apply addition and subtraction strategies to solve equations
- illustrate and explain addition and subtraction using column method

## Science

We will be learning to:

- compare different conditions for plants to grow and be healthy
- observe animals growing over time
- notice that animals, including humans, have offspring which grow into adults
- find out about and describe the basic needs of animals including humans for survival

## Geography

We will be learning about:

- seasonal and daily weather patterns in The United Kingdom
- the location of hot and cold areas in the world in relation to the Equator and North and South poles

## Computing

We will be using a computer to create music.

We will listen to a variety of pieces of music and consider how music can make us feel and explore the different thoughts a piece of music can bring to mind.
