In English we will:

- write instructions for how to get home



We will be learning to:

- read, write, represent, compare and order numbers up to 50
- explore addition and subtraction involving 2-digit numbers and ones
- investigate number bonds within 20
- name coins and notes and understand their value
- represent the same value using different coins

Science

We will be learning to:

- identify and name a variety of common wild and garden plants
- observe how plants change over a period of time
- observe changes across seasons
- make weekly observations and record results using photographs, tables and labelled diagrams



Geography

We will be learning about:

- human features within the different countries in the United Kingdom
- how to identify characteristics of the United Kingdom and its surrounding areas

Computing
