

English

The children will continue to learn in their reading groups, exploring different texts.

In their whole class English sessions the children will start by exploring **When Stars are Scattered** by Victoria Jamieson and Omar Mohamed. They will read and write about this moving refugee story.



Maths

The children will start the summer term examining units of measure including metric units for length, mass and capacity.

They will then move on to explore calculating with whole numbers and decimals, including how to apply their times tables knowledge in a range of contexts.

The children will then move on to recapping their knowledge of 2D and 3D shapes.

Science

In summer term, the children will learn about plant and animal life cycles.

We will be learning;

- the differences between mammal, amphibian and bird life cycles
- the life processes of reproduction in some plants and animals



Geography

The new topic is Trade and this will introduce the children to;

- the concept of trading goods locally and internationally
- how imports and exports impact life in the United Kingdom
- how physical geography impacts what countries trade

Computing

We will be learning how to create vector drawings by layering different shapes.
