Family Survey Feedback
October 2022



91.2% of families either strongly agreed or agreed that their child is happy at Shacklewell Primary School.



90.2% of families reported that their child feels safe at Shacklewell Primary School.

We asked you if you agreed that the school makes sure that it's pupils are well behaved- 88.4% said yes.

We asked you if you think that the school makes you aware of what your child will learn during the term and 86.5% agreed or strongly agreed.



92.1% of responses indicate that you believe that your child does well at Shacklewell.
