Year 6 & PGL Osmington Bay Update

We are so looking forward to travelling to Osmington Bay for an exciting five-day adventure at the Dorset PGL Centre on **Monday 6th - Friday 10th February 2023**.

In preparation for our visit, please read this letter carefully as it contains key information including essential items your child will need to bring. A reminder of our PGL powerpoint has been shared via our texting service and paper copies are also available from our school office.

Travel arrangements

- All children should arrive at school on **Monday 6th February at 09:30am** with one suitcase and one small bag or backpack containing a packed lunch. We will provide packed lunches for children entitled to a free school meal.
- Children will travel with their teachers on a private coach which will leave school approximately 10:15am. We will need to know if your child suffers from travel sickness.
- The journey is around 5-6 hours, depending on traffic and includes lunch and toilet stops. Please be mindful when preparing your child's packed lunch - no sweets, fizzy drinks nor any products that contain sesame or nuts – let's keep our children with allergies safe!
- The children will return to school on **Friday 10th February at approx. 6.30pm**. We will keep you updated.

Medication and first aid

- There will be a lead first aider who will be responsible for administering any prescribed medication during the trip. Only medications prescribed to your child by a GP will be administered and must be handed to our lead first aider on Monday 6th February 2023. This medication **MUST** match the medication information provided on the medical consent form which you would have completed for your child. Please **DO NOT** pack any medication, vitamins, travel sickness tablets etc in your child's suitcase.
- Only medications prescribed to your child by a doctor will be administered, with the exception of travel sickness tablets or vitamins supplements. You will need to complete a '*permission to administer medication*' form. PGL staff are all first aid trained however there will be a member of the school with each activity group at all times.

Pocket Money

- There is a shop on the site which sells souvenirs, small toys, sweets and snacks. The children will have a chance to visit the shop across the week.
- Children may bring a **maximum of £20**. Money should be handed in on the morning of 6th February. We will keep it in a named envelope. Money will be given out at each shop visit and any change returned on our arrival back to school.

Please be reminded that children are not allowed to bring any mobiles, tablets, games consoles or gadgets of any kind on the trip.

We have slots available to book if you would like to speak with myself, Ms Williams or Ms Sykes regarding any specific concerns about your child, just contact our school office.

We wish all the Year 6 children a fun, happy, safe and memorable experience and of course, should you need any further information please do get in touch with our school office team.
