Understanding the World

The children will have the opportunity to walk around the local community and explore some old toys.

Draw a map of your route to school. Talk to your child about the toys you liked to play with when you were a child.

Literacy - Writing

The children will enjoy learning our talk for writing text: 'The Three Little Pigs'. We will be drawing pictures from the story and using our letter sounds to label them.

Ask your child to show you the actions they have learnt so far.

Help your child create patterns using different materials, such as pasta and rice, at home.
