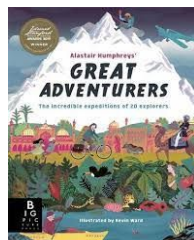
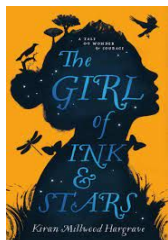
Living Things and their Habitats



Reading & Writing

We will be learning how to:

- make and justify inferences about a text
- explain and evidence our ideas about a text
- develop our stamina to allow us to write longer, sustained pieces of work



Maths

We will be learning how to:

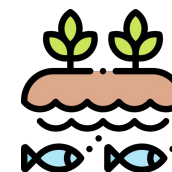
- represent, read, write, order and compare numbers up to ten million
- round numbers, make estimates and use this to solve problems in context
- solve multi-step problems involving addition and subtraction



Science

We will be learning how to:

- describe how living things are classified into broad groups according to common observable characteristics
- give reasons for classifying plants and animals based on specific characteristics

We will be learning how to:

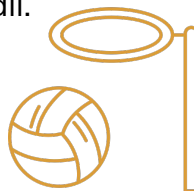
- identify how climate zones and physical geography differ in varied locations
