

English

In English, we will:

- continue to learn new sounds and build reading fluency in RWI;
- read *The Snail and the Whale* and *The Last Wolf*;
- use capital letters, full stops and finger spaces consistently and begin to use question marks;
- write descriptions and fact files, including 'and' to join ideas in sentences.



Maths

In maths, we will be learning to:

- measure length and mass using non-standard units;
- compare different measurements and describe them accurately;
- read and write numbers from 1 to 10 in numerals and words;
- identify one more and one less within 10;
- recognise and name common 2-D and 3-D shapes.



Science

In science, we will be learning about animals and the human body. We will:

- identify and name a range of common animals;
- describe and compare the characteristics of animals;
- classify animals according to what they eat;
- identify, name and draw the basic parts of the human body.



History

In history, we will be exploring our living history. We will:

- think about what school is like now and how schools have changed since our parents' and grandparents' time;
- explore how historians learn from artefacts and interviews;
- create a simple timeline of our school;
- show other people what our school was like in the past.

Computing

In computing, we will be learning how to paint digitally. We will:

- use the freehand tool to make marks and draw lines;
- use the line and shape tools to imitate the work of artists such as Piet Mondrian and Henri Matisse;
- create our own digital paintings.



Physical Education

In PE, we will be focusing on activities that develop our running, jumping and throwing skills. We will also be developing our attacking, defending and shooting skills.
