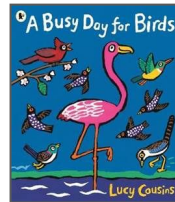
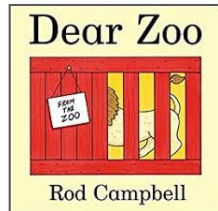




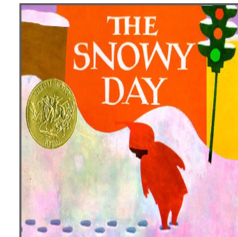
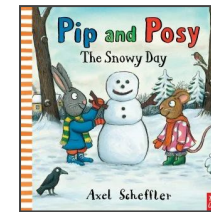
Caterpillar Class - Spring 1

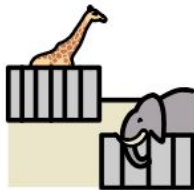

Encourage your child to touch each object as they count to 5.

Understanding the World

We will be focusing on gaining a better understanding of our animals, thinking about how they move and the noises they make.

Encourage your child to talk about what they can see when out and about.

We will be investigating different sounds and musical instruments. We will be exploring a range of craft media such as playdough, painting, collaging, cutting, gluing and sticking!
