English

In English, we will be:

- Reading Beowulf and Anglo-Saxon Boy to develop our fluency and comprehension;
- Writing a legend and building our own mythical creatures inspired by Beowulf;
- Writing an explanation text using You Wouldn't Want to be an Anglo-Saxon Peasant.







Maths

In maths, we will be learning to:

- Convert fractions to decimals including tenths, quarters and halves;
- Compare and order numbers with the same number of decimal places;
- Multiply and divide by 10 and 100 including decimals;
- Find the area and perimeter of 2D shapes;
- Identify lines of symmetry in 2D shapes.



Science

In science, we will complete our Electricity unit and begin our Identification and Classification unit. We will:

- Design circuits with different components including switches;
- Recognise common conductors and insulators;
- Identify and group a variety of living things in the local environment;
- Use and create classification keys to name living things found in different habitats.

History

Our history topic is **The Anglo Saxons.** We will be learning:

- What Britain was like after Roman rule:

- How the Anglo-Saxons lived and ruled;
- The impact of Christianity on the Anglo-Saxons:
