English

In English, we will be:

- Reading books at our level to develop our fluency and comprehension.
- Writing a moral story inspired by The Magic Finger, using different techniques to build tension.
- Writing a biography and autobiography in the style of Coming to England.





Maths

In maths, we will be learning to:

- Identify right angles;
- Calculate the perimeter of simple 2D shapes;
- Tell, record, write and order the time: analogue, digital, am and pm.
- Measure, calculate and compare durations;
- Understand fractions as part of a whole, a set and a number;
- Add, subtract, compare and order fractions.

Science

We will complete our **Rocks** unit then begin our **Plants** unit. We will:

- Investigate the water retention of different soils;
- Observe and explain how soils can be separated through sedimentation;
- Identify and describe the functions of different parts of flowering plants: roots, stem, leaves and flowers;
- Investigate the way in which water is transported within plants.

History

Our History topic is **Ancient Civilisations**. We will be learning about:

- The achievements of the earliest civilisations and understand where and when they first appeared;
- Ancient Sumner, Ancient
 Egypt, Ancient China and the
 Indus Valley and compare
 these to the Stone Age,
 Bronze Age and Iron Age in
 Britain.
