English

In English, we will:

- Read The Last Tree and That Rabbit Belongs to Emily Brown;
- Continue to build our reading fluency and comprehension;
- Write a comic with captions;
- Write a newspaper article;
- Write a missing poster for the character Stanley.





Maths

In maths, we will be learning to:

- Recognise symbols for pounds and pence;
- Combine notes and coins in different ways to make a given monetary value;
- Explore, sort and describe 2D shapes;
- Find lines of symmetry in 2D shapes;
- Compare and sort 2D and 3D shapes;
- Use language to describe position and direction.

Science

We will begin our **Growing Plants** topic, learning to:

- Research when and how to plant seeds and bulbs;
- Know what plants need to begin to grow;
- Identify plants that grow well in different conditions;
- Observe and compare how plants grow inside and outside over time.



Our history topic is **Marvellous Medics**. We will be learning about:

- Medical care in the 1800s;
- Joseph Lister, John Snow and Elizabeth Garrett Anderson;
- Florence Nightingale and Mary Seacole's contribution to the medical care of soldiers during the Crimean War;
- The legacy and impact of Florence Nightingale and Mary Seacole's lives on modern health care.

Computing

Our computing topic is **Pictograms.** We will be learning:
