

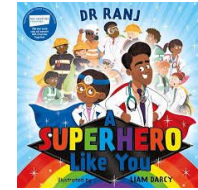
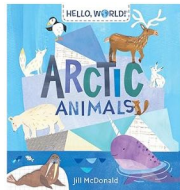
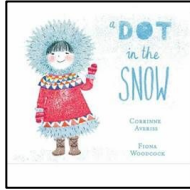


Reception - Summer 1

Key Experiences

We will take part in a charity event to adopt a polar bear.

Visits from different people who help us and different occupations.

Personal, Social & Emotional Development

We will be learning about the lives of people around us and their roles within society. We will also be learning to show care and sympathy towards all living creatures and endangered animals.

Talk to your child about how to care for their pets or different animals.

Physical Development

We will continue to develop our gross motor skills through dance and movement inspired by the animals we are learning about. We will be showing accuracy and care when drawing.

Practise a step by step drawing of an Arctic animal with your child.

Communication & Language

We will be asking questions to find out more about our favourite animals and people who help us. We will be discussing the different occupations we see in our local area.

Talk to your child about the different occupations and the people who help them in their local community.

Literacy - Reading

We will imitate the traditional tale of "Goldilocks" and create our own versions, with new characters! We will also continue to read a range of non-fiction and information books.

Explore different non-fiction texts at home to find out new information.

Literacy - Writing

We will continue to practise our writing skills by making our own invitations, shopping lists and mini stories using the sounds we know. We're working on remembering capital letters, fingers spaces and a full stop.

Involve your child in purposeful writing at home, making posters or writing your 'to do' lists!

Maths

We will be automatically recalling number bonds up to 5 and some to 10. We will explore the composition of numbers to 10 and investigate addition and subtraction using a range of resources.

Explore different representations to 10 and number facts using objects at home.

Understanding the World

We will be learning about similarities and differences between different religious and cultural communities in this country, drawing on their experiences. We will learn about about life at the Arctic and and compare it to our own lives. Look up some animals that live in the Arctic and find some facts about them! Talk to your child about different festivals.

Expressive Art & Design

We will safely use and explore a variety of materials, tools and techniques, experimenting with colour, design, texture, form and function to create our own model animals and crafts.
