## Personal, Social & Emotional Development

This term will focus on problem-solving. We will be encouraging the children to talk about their feelings when there's a problem and find positive solutions. Encourage your child to name their emotions and think about solutions.

## Understanding the World

We will be focusing on gaining a better understanding of the summer season by observing the changes in nature and having fun in the sun.

Talk to your child about sun safety and keeping hydrated when the weather gets hot.

## Literacy

We will be focusing on reading longer stories linked to our themes and talking about what happens in them.
