- writing a biography and autobiography in the style of Coming to England.






Maths

In maths, we will be learning to:

- compare and measure lengths and mass using cm and kg.
- double and halve numbers.
- explore, sort and describe 2D shapes.
- find lines of symmetry in 2D shapes.
- compare and sort 2D and 3D shapes.
- use language to describe position and direction.



Science

We will complete our **Rocks** unit then begin our **Plants** unit. We will:

- investigate the water retention of different soils.
- observe and explain how soils can be separated through sedimentation.
- identify and describe the functions of different parts of flowering plants: roots, stem, leaves and flowers.
- investigate the way in which water is transported within plants.

History

Our history topic is **Ancient Egypt.**We will be learning about:

- the Ancient Egyptians and their beliefs.
- mummification and burial practices.
- how we are able to know so much about the lives of Ancient Egyptians.
- how museum artefacts such as those at The British and Petrie Museums can teach us about life in the past.

Computing
