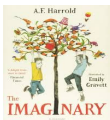
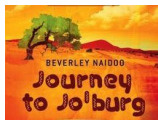


Reading

- Approach problems in a variety of ways to solve and prove our reasoning
- Use Strategies to solve multi-step problems
