## Key Vocabulary

<b>urban habitat</b>	habitat that exists in a city
<b>bulb</b>	part of some plants that stays underground, it stores food for the plant
<b>hedges (hedgerows)</b>	strips of woodland edge habitat
<b>predict</b>	a scientific guess
<b>observe</b>	watching something carefully to spot any changes
<b>record</b>	drawing or writing down the information found when observing
