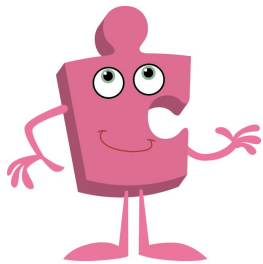
British Empire
